## CHARDONNAY

- Kendall Jackson 'Vintner's Reserve' (California) 39.  
Full-bodied and fruity, with plenty of oak and vanilla overtones.
- Sonoma Cutrer Russian River Ranches 48.  
(Sonoma, California) half bottle 25.  
Well-balanced with fruit and oak in perfect harmony.
- Four Vines Naked (Santa Barbara, California) 33.  
Crisp and dry with perfect acidity.
- Cambria Katherine's Vineyard 36.  
(Santa Maria Valley, California)  
Oak spice aromas. Citrus, pineapple, white peach and apple flavors.

## SAUVIGNON BLANC

- Terra Libre Fumé Blanc (Mendoza, Argentina) 29.  
Firm and focused, with hints of citrus; perfect with chicken.
- Brancott (Marlborough, New Zealand) 32.  
Flavors and scents of grapefruit.
- Cloudy Bay (New Zealand) 55.  
A vibrant mix of lime, lemon zest and nectarine aromatics with a hint of orange blossom on the nose.
- Ashbourne (Walker Bay, South Africa) 31.  
80% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Chardonnay.  
A terrific blend with bright acidity and fruit.

## RIESLING

- Chateau Ste. Michelle (Columbia Valley, WA) 29.  
Aromas of honeysuckle, flavors of ripe pear.
- Willamette Valley Vineyards 31.  
(Willamette Valley, Oregon)  
Crisp and rich with pear notes.

## PINOT GRIGIO

- Placido (Venezie, Italy) 28.  
Crisp and bright; a perfect start to a great meal.
- San Angelo (Tuscany, Italy) 39.  
Refreshing, with a touch of citrus.
- Bollini (Trentino, Italy) 33.  
From Italy's northern most growing region; crisp and fruity.
- Santa Margherita (Valdadige, Italy) 63.  
All that Pinot Grigio can be! Great fruit, focus and acidity.

## OTHER WHITES

- Sea Monster White Blend (Central Coast, CA) 25.  
An intriguing blend of four aromatic white grapes; from local winemaking legend, Christian Tietje and Adam LaZarre. Exotic and tropical.
- Louis Jadot Pouilly-Fuisse (Burgundy, France) 57.  
From one of France's top producers.
- T. Matrot Bourgogne Blanc (Burgundy, France) 47.  
Made from 100% Burgundian Chardonnay grapes; a perfect expression of the region's terroir.
- J. C. Pichot Vouvray (Loire, France) 35.  
100% Chenin Blanc grapes; hints of peach nectar.
- Patient Cottat Sancerre (Loire, France) 50.  
Mineral aromas with great concentration, balanced acidity and herbaceous flavors.

## CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

- Dom Perignon (Champagne, France) 266.  
From the monk who invented the Champagne process.
- Moët & Chandon Imperial (Champagne, France) 88.  
Rich and fruity with a hint of sweetness.
- Domine Careros Blanc de Noir (Careros, California) 43.  
Beautiful salmon color with pinpoint bubbles. Owned by Taittinger of Champagne.
- Canella Prosecco (Veneto, Italy) 187ml bottle 11.25  
Bright, lively and refreshing.
- Domaine Chandon Brut Rose 187ml bottle 12.25  
(Careros, California)  
Hints of bright strawberry and citrus.

## BLUSH

- Beringer White Zinfandel (California) 26.  
Mouth-watering fruit flavors with a moderately sweet palate.
- Perrin Dry Rose (Rhône, France) 30.  
Dry, crisp and refreshing with hints of rose petals.

### CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Cassis and red-currant fruit flavors with silky tannins and a long finish.

Full, rich and well balanced.

Well-balanced, with a touch of Merlot in the blend for softness.
- St Francis (Sonoma, CA) 45.  
Beautiful depth with layers of black currant flavors.
- Sterling (Napa, California) 62.  
Rich & full-bodied with outstanding balance & mouth-feel.

### PINOT NOIR

- Steele (Carneros, California) ½ bottle 30.  
Moderate oak, juicy fruit flavors and black cherry aromas.
- Cono Sur (Colchagua, Chile) 29.  
Bright flavors of plum, cherry with hints of mocha.
- Willamette Valley Vineyards "Whole Cluster"  
(Willamette Valley, Oregon) 50.  
Dark, juicy and spicy, with great depth.
- Montinore Estate (Willamette Valley, Oregon) 39.  
Made in the traditional French style; round & supple with layers of fruit.

### MERLOT

- Cannonball (California) 35.  
Fresh cherries, rich chocolate and spiced cake.
- Ava Grace (California) 26.  
Soft, fruity and silky.
- Kendall Jackson 'Vintner's RSV' (CA) ½ bottle 21.  
Smooth berry, cassis and raspberry notes with a hint of toast.
- L'Ecole No. 41 (Columbia Valley, Washington) 52.  
Layered with aromas of black cherry, violet and plum.  
Full bodied with balanced layers of red fruit and cocoa.

### MALBEC

- Tinto Negro Reserve (Mendoza, Argentina) 33.  
Takes Malbec to a new level; beautiful fruit and balance.
- Angulo Innocenti NONNI (Mendoza, Argentina) 27.  
Fresh dark fruit aromas and flavors with soft round tannins.

### SYRAH / SHIRAZ

- Bulletin Place (Australia) 34.  
Warm and rich with spicy softness.
- Jed Steele's Shooting Star (Lake County, California) 35.  
Jed is a great man and a super winemaker. A must try!

### ZINFANDEL

- Klinker Brick Old Vines Zinfandel (California) 38.  
Dark and rich with notes of black cherry and pepper.  
A composition of fruit from 18 vineyards with average vine age of 88 years!
- Seghesio (Sonoma, California) ½ bottle 26.  
Concentrated tastes of raspberry, black cherry, anise and black pepper.
- Four Vines Biker (Paso Robles, California) 42.  
Rugged, peppery and rich.

### FRENCH REDS

- Louis Jadot Beaujolais-Villages (Burgundy, France) 32.  
Hints of strawberry; bright and fresh.
- Perrin Cotes du Rhone (Rhône, France) 34.  
From the owners of Chateau Beaucastel; smooth and rich.  
Bordeaux's largest estate; perfect with red meats.
- Château Puy Blanquet St. Émilion Grand Cru  
(Bordeaux, France) 61  
Firm, focused and well balanced. Plum, spices and mocha.

### ITALIAN REDS/OTHER REDS

- Ruffino Riserva Ducale Chianti "Tan" (Tuscany, Italy) 57.  
"The Duke's Wine"; soft tannins, great depth, terrific with pasta.
- Monte Antico Rosso (Tuscany, Italy) 35.  
A fantastic blend of traditional Sangiovese and non-traditional Cabernet Sauvignon grapes.
- Mazzei Zisola (Sicily, Italy) 68.  
100% Nero d'Avola - The Black Devil! Full, spicy and rich, from one of Italy's most famous winemaking families.
- Marqués de Cáceres Reserva (Rioja, Spain) 43.  
Berries and a hint of spice, with a slight depth of floral notes.
- Patelin de Tablas Rhone Style Blend  
(Paso Robles, California) 40.  
Meaty with black plum, boysenberry and nice powdered sugar tannins.
